- Commitments at \$15,000 or more: Donors at this level will be afforded an ***acknowledgement opportunity*** via a personal plaque placed to recognize their generosity in making possible a particular aspect of the project:

i.e. “Audio-visual system made possible through the generosity of John and Mary Smith”

- All Commitments at \$2,000 or more: Each donor at \$2,000 or more ***will be listed*** on a 50th Anniversary Project plaque located inside the Church front entry listing donors at each giving level – *Legacy, Leadership or Loyalty.*
